

Policy Adoption

Any of these policies and regulations may be suspended temporarily at any meeting when three-fourths of the entire School Committee shall vote therefore. Policy proposals and suggested amendments to or revisions of existing policies shall be submitted to all members of the School Committee and to the superintendent in writing prior to a regularly scheduled School Committee meeting in which such proposed policies, amendments, or revisions shall be given first reading and discussed. A vote for adoption shall take place at the next appropriate regular meeting of the School Committee. Action shall be by majority vote of the total School Committee. Minutes of each meeting shall reflect any readings and action taken.

Development of all such proposals for new or amended policies prior to their submission to the School Committee for action shall include, to the fullest extent practical, deliberative discussions with all persons to be affected or their representatives.
